## NOTICE OF KNOX COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD MEETING

The Knox County Air Pollution Control Board will meet in a regular session at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 21, 2021, and determining that meeting electronically is necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of Tennesseans in light of the COVID-19 outbreak, the meeting will be held in the following manner pursuant to State of Tennessee Executive Order By The Governor No. 78:

The meeting will be conducted permitting participation electronically via Zoom. Regulatory changes concerning the following sections will be discussed and acted upon:

Section 25.0: Permits

Section 41.0: Regulation for the Review of New Sources

Section 45.0: Prevention of Significant Deterioration

These regulatory changes will allow the public notices required for public participation on permit actions to be published on Air Quality's website and will remove the associated publishing fee.

After adoption, copies of these regulatory changes and revisions, as well as all current Knox County Air Quality Management Regulations, will be available at a reasonable cost in the Knox County Air Quality Management department office. These items will also be available on-line at [www.knoxcounty.org/airquality](http://www.knoxcounty.org/airquality).

The meeting's agenda also consists of the Director's update and a report on recent enforcement activities.
