## **PRESS RELEASE**

Knox County Circuit Court Clerk Cathy Quist announced this week that her office will begin accepting pleadings for circuit court cases at the Knox County Juvenile Court beginning Wednesday, August 15.

Knox County Juvenile Court is located at 3323 Division Street.

Previously any documents filed in circuit court had to be accepted at the clerk's office in the City County Building in downtown Knoxville.

Quist said the decision to begin receiving documents at the juvenile court counter came in response to a growing number of requests from attorneys located outside of downtown for a filing site closer to their locations.

"One of my goals is making the court more accessible for everyone that uses it, and I think this move is certainly a step toward accomplishing that," said Quist, who is also the Knox County Juvenile Court Clerk. "It makes things a little more convenient and we're pleased to offer the service."

Circuit Court documents filed at the Knox County Juvenile Court Clerk's counter will be picked up at noon each day. That means, for example that a pleading filed on Tuesday morning would be delivered to the circuit court clerk's office that afternoon.

A pleading filed after noon on Tuesday, however, would not arrive at the circuit court clerk's office until the following day.
