THIS THURSDAY EVENING, AUGUST 14, 2014, THERE WILL BE A PUBLIC FORUM AT 6:00 PM IN THE AUDITORIUM OF GRESHAM MIDDLE SCHOOL, 500 GRESHAM ROAD, TO INTRODUCE THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE SUBMITTED RESUMES FOR THE THREE MONTH INTERIM APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO REPRESENT THE SECOND DISTRICT. AT THIS POINT, TEN RESUMES HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED.

THE FORUM IS BEING SPONSORED BY THE LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS AND THE KNOX COUNTY EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, AND BETH HAYNES OF WBIR WILL BE MODERATING.

THE FORMAT IS AS FOLLOWS:

CANDIDATES WILL DRAW NUMBERS FOR SEATING AND QUESTION ORDER. BETH HAYNES WILL INTRODUCE THEM, PROVIDING A BRIEF SUMMARY FROM THEIR BIOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION. QUESTIONS WILL FOLLOW A ROTATION, WITH 90 SECONDS FOR ANSWERS. A TIMER WILL KEEP THEM ON TRACK. BEGINNING QUESTIONS WILL COME FROM A LEAGUE AND KCEA COMMITTEE, AND SUBSEQUENT ONES WILL COME FROM THE AUDIENCE. AT THE END, EACH WILL HAVE TWO MINUTES FOR A CLOSING STATEMENT. KEEP IN MIND THAT THIS IS A FORUM, NOT A DEBATE, AND IS INTENDED TO INFORM THE RESIDENTS OF THE SECOND DISTRICT, AS WELL AS ANY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PRESENT, OF THEIR QUALIFICATIONS.

SEVERAL COMMISSIONERS MAY BE IN ATTENDANCE, SO MINUTES MAY BE TAKEN. NO VOTES WILL BE TAKEN. THE PRESS AND PUBLIC ARE WELCOME.
