Background:

KNOXVILLE (Oct. 22, 2015) – Knox County Mayor Tim Burchett will formally dedicate the Connor Road bridge over Bullrun Creek on Tuesday, Oct. 27 at 10:30 a.m. in memory of Corporal Lawrence E. Lett, Navy Cross and Silver Star recipient, 1st Marine Division, US Marine Corps. Cpl Lett was killed in action while serving in Korea on Oct. 27, 1952.
