

Ballot Questions:

**QUESTIONS PROPOSED AND APPROVED BY THE
KNOX COUNTY CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE CHARTER
FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE KNOX COUNTY CHARTER:**

Question 1: Shall Section 3.09 of the Knox County Charter be repealed and, instead, shall the Charter be amended to add a new Article IV entitled “Other Officers” to provide for the duties of the Assessor of Property in the Knox County Property Assessor, the duties of the Sheriff in the Knox County Sheriff, the duties of the Register of Deeds in the Knox County Register of Deeds, the duties of the County Clerk in the Knox County County Clerk and the duties of the Trustee in the Knox County Trustee, all of whose elections, duties, qualifications, oaths of office, bond requirements and compensation are governed by the Constitution and laws of the State of Tennessee and the Charter of Knox County, unless otherwise amended by this charter, and whose appointment, in the event of a vacancy, shall be filled in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Tennessee and the Charter of Knox County, as more fully set forth in the Charter Review Committee Proposed Amendments, as duly published, (such that current Article IV shall be renumbered Article V and the subsequent Articles shall be renumbered accordingly)?

Question 2: Shall the Knox County Charter be amended to codify a new Section 3.10 which shall create the County Code Commission, with the responsibility of collecting and publishing in a bound volume the Knox County Charter, any amendments to the Charter, and all ordinances and emergency ordinances of the Knox County Commission, as more fully set forth in the Charter Review Committee Proposed Amendments, as duly published?

Question 3: Shall Section 7.03 of the Knox County Charter be amended to conform with state law regarding primary election qualifying deadlines by placing a period after the phrase “in compliance with general law” in the first sentence of that section, and deleting the remainder of that sentence?
