Process Details

The county pays 60% and the applicant(s) pays 40% of the total project costs. In order to participate in the program you must send a completed application to Knox County Stormwater. Once approved we will create a design plan. Based upon our design you will request an estimate from one of our approved contractors. If we both agree on the estimate then the project goes forward. Once the work is completed the contractor will bill the County for 60% and you, the applicant, for 40% of the project costs.
