If you no longer own the property but owned the property at the time that the taxes were due, you are still responsible for the taxes. You should pay the taxes directly and seek reimbursement from the new owner. The new owner should also contact the Property Assessor's office to complete a change of ownership and change of address form. You should also call the Trustee's Office to provide the new owners name and address for our records.

BANKRUPTCY: If you received a discharge or are currently a debtor in bankruptcy, Knox County is NOT seeking to collect from you personally. If you are currently a debtor in a pending bankruptcy case and once the Knox County Trustee is made aware, this case will not proceed against your property without permission from the bankruptcy court. Please confirm with your bankruptcy attorney that the Knox County Trustee has been notified of your bankruptcy case.
