2019 East Tennessee Development Symposium

Mayor Glenn Jacobs welcomes attendees to development conference as region expects continued growth in 2019

BACKGROUND: This two-day event is a powerful platform to network with hundreds of professionals and to share knowledge, lessons learned and best practices in the development field. Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs will welcome Symposium attendees on the second day of the East Tennessee Development Symposium. The conference is hosted by the Tennessee Stormwater Association, Knox County and other local municipalities, the Home Builders Association of Greater Knoxville, consulting engineering firms and other development stakeholders.
