Mayor Jacobs Talks Greenways, Reading, Sales Tax, and More

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— During his Weekly Update, which will post about 3 p.m. today, Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs talks about the Northshore Greenway project, Read Across America Day, and meetings with some of the members of the state General Assembly in Nashville

"One of the things that we talked about was lowering the sales tax administrative fee the State charges counties, which will help us keep more of our sales tax here in Knox County," Mayor Jacobs says.
