Knox County Growth Policy Coordinating Committee Meeting Switched to 11-27

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.—Members of the Knox County Growth Policy Coordinating Committee will hold their second public meeting on Monday, Nov. 27 to hear from the public and consider amendments to the Growth Policy Plan. Please note that this meeting was initially scheduled for Nov. 16.

The meeting will take place at 5 p.m. in the Main Assembly Room of the City County Building. The committee previously met on Oct. 24 to hear a presentation about the Advance Knox process and the proposed amendment. The meeting was for informational purposes only.

Knox County began the process to create its first Comprehensive Land Use and Transportation Plan several years ago. Advance Knox was a data driven process to create a plan to guide growth, land use, transportation, economic prosperity, and quality of life for years to come. To support the county's growing population, housing needs and businesses, the Growth Policy Plan must be updated.

Though Knox County has experienced significant growth, the Growth Policy Plan hasn't been updated in almost 20 years. Updating the map and plan are an important piece of this process. After two years of community engagement on this project, and working with a team of consultants, we are ready to move forward with a plan for adoption.
