Knox County Seeks Input on East Knox County Mobility Study

BACKGROUND: Knox County will host two public information meetings to seek community input on the East Knox Mobility Study. These meetings will help identify key transportation challenges, set priorities, and shape the final recommendations for the study.

The first public information meeting is on Thursday, November 7, 2024, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Carter High School. The second meeting is on Wednesday, November 13, 2024, from 5 to 7 p.m. at Gibbs Middle School. Both meetings will discuss the same material.

Feedback is requested in three areas: a public survey, interactive map for transportation concerns and ideas, and an interactive map for project feedback.
