



## 2025/2026 Contribution Limit Changes

Contribution Limits have been updated for the 2023 and 2024 calendar years based on Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-10-301 et seq. The new limits are effective for any election<sup>1</sup> held in 2023 and/or 2024.
