August 1, 2024 Elections: Statistics at the Conclusion of Early Voting

Knoxville – Saturday, July 27th marked the end of early voting for the August 1, 2024 Knox County General, Federal/State Primary, and Town of Farragut Municipal Election. A total of **31,294 early votes have been cast**, with an additional **2,061 votes cast by absentee ballot and in nursing homes**.

REGISTERED VOTERS in KNOX COUNTY (as of Saturday, July 27, 2024) - 303,541.

NEW VOTERS: A total of <u>643 first-time voters</u> cast ballots during early voting.

<u>VOTERS 100 AND OVER</u>: A total of <u>twelve (12) voters 100 years of age or older</u> have voted. The <u>oldest is 106 years</u> old.
