## November 5, 2024 Election: Statistics at the Halfway Point of Early Voting

Knoxville – Wednesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> marked the halfway point (seven days of fourteen) of early voting for the November 5, 2024 Presidential and Federal/State General Election.

Through the first seven days, a total of 80,845 early votes have been cast in Knox County, with an additional 5,067 votes cast by absentee ballot and in nursing homes.

There are <u>336,151 registered voters</u> (318,311 active; 17,840 inactive) in Knox County as of Wednesday, October 23, 2024.
