Knox County Election Commission's Provisional Ballot Counting Board and Post-Election Audit Information

Knoxville - The Knox County Election Commission's schedule for post-election activities is as follows:

- The **Provisional Ballot Counting Board** will meet on <u>Tuesday, November 12 at 9 a.m.</u> at the west office of the Election Commission to consider 661 provisional ballots cast during the November 5, 2024 election.
- Also on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 12</u>, <u>2024 at 9 am</u>, <u>the Knox County Election Commission will conduct a post-election audit</u> of five (5) election day precincts and one (1) early voting location. The precincts and location to be audited are:
 - Election Day Precinct 11 Central United Methodist Church
 - Election Day Precinct 19 Thrive Lonsdale
 - Election Day Precinct 37 Inskip Elementary School
 - Election Day Precincts 60/61E/61W Halls High School
 - o Election Day Precincts 65W/65SW Faith Lutheran Church
 - Early Voting Knoxville Expo Center

The locations were randomly chosen by the Election Commission after the polls closed on election night. The audit will take place at the west office of the Election Commission, 109 Lovell Heights Road.
