The following is for Clarification:

- **Question 1:** Does the district intend to award multiple vendors?
- **Answer 1:** The district is open to the possibility of awarding multiple vendors.

Question 2: Can a vendor submit a solution for a partial grade band?

- Answer 2: Yes.
- Question 3: In the requirement for training, the district requires vendors to complete a train-thetrainers model service by July 31, 2019. Our train-the-trainer model provides initial seminars then follow-up seminars close to screening dates three times a year. We found success with ongoing touch points to for trainers that gives them ample opportunities to apply their knowledge, gain practical experience, and ask questions to help deepen implementation. Can a vendor provide initial training by that date and follow-up seminars after screening dates?
- Answer 3: Yes.
- **Question 4:** Does the county have a deadline/milestone when the system should be implemented?
- **Answer 4:** The system needs to be in place, ready for universal screening and progress monitoring prior to the beginning of School Year 2019-20.
- **Question 5:** Would the county be open to a custom software solution?
- Answer 5: We are open to solutions that will meet the requirements set by our state's regulations set in the State RTI2 Framework.
