

## NOTICE TO BIDDERS

All Qualified Bidders are invited to submit bids on the **PEDESTRIAN CROSSING AT SOUTH DOYLE HIGH SCHOOL – TIPTON STATION ROAD - BID NO. 2960**. The Project consists of grading, drainage, base, paving, signs, retaining walls and bridges for the proposed Pedestrian Crossing at South Doyle High School – Tipton Station Road.

Bids will be received at the Knox County Procurement Division, 1000 N. Central Street, Suite 100, Knoxville, TN 37917 on or before Wednesday, June 17, 2020 until 4:00 p.m., local time, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud and the Contract awarded as soon thereafter as practicable. Bidders must use the bid envelope cover sheet provided in the project manual and include their Full Name, Address, and Tennessee Contractor's License Number and deposit the bid in the Knox County Procurement Bid Box.

Bidders must obtain Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents at the office of Robert G. Campbell & Associates, 7523 Taggart Lane, Knoxville, TN 37938, Telephone 865-947-5996, at a cost of \$100.00. Non-successful plan holders will be re-funded this cost if the plans are returned within 10 days and in good condition.

A **mandatory** pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 26, 2020 at 10:00 A.M. local time. The meeting will be held at the Project Site, South Doyle High School, 2020 Tipton Station Road, Knoxville, TN. Bidders **must** have a representative present at the mandatory pre-bid meeting for their bids to be considered.

All Bidders must be licensed Contractors as required by the "CONTRACTOR'S LICENSING ACT OF 1976," and as passed by the 89th General Assembly of the State of Tennessee. Furthermore, the Contractor should have the necessary licensing classifications as listed in Rules of Tennessee Board for Licensing General Contractors-Chapter 0680-1.

Each Bid must be accompanied by a certified check or by a Bidder's Bond executed by the Bidder and a surety company licensed to do business in Tennessee, in the sum of five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid.

The successful Bidder will be required to execute an acceptable performance and payment bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price within thirty (30) days of contract award notice.

Knox County reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all bids and to accept the bid deemed most favorable to the interest of the County.
