#### **Questions/Answers:**

Question 1: The current structure of the funding in the RFP leans heavily on the education component, leaving little revenue for implementation and action. Is this budget and scope flexible?

Answer 1: The RFP provides proposers with flexibility to focus only on their educational efforts. The County uses the non-educational portion of the litter grant to support litter removal activities. Proposers are expected to propose how they will use the educational amount of the grant for educational purposes. For instance, the total Fiscal Year 2024 TDOT Litter Grant to Knox County will \$171,400, of which, 35% (\$59,990) will be allocated for Litter Education under this contract in the coming year. Proposers may choose how to spend the educational funds among the listed target groups/areas. The evaluation committee will assess all proposers based on the evaluation criteria listed. Proposers may also propose costs for supplemental or extra services for adopt-a-road or coordination services, and any proposed pricing for those services may be negotiated with the highest evaluated proposer.
