The Knox County Retirement & Pension Board will hold its election for two seats on the Board. The charter requires active participants in the retirement to select two (2) active participants as members of the Retirement Board each two (2) years for four (4) year terms. The new members elected by participants at this election will begin their term beginning March 2015 – February 2019 following their election.

Seat A, be filled by a representative from the Knox County Schools Classified employees participating in the Asset Accumulation Plan or Defined Benefit Plan; and,

Seat B, be filled by a representative from the Knox County Government participating in the Asset Accumulation Plan, Defined Benefit Plan, Sheriff's Total Accumulation Retirement Plan, the Uniformed Officers Pension Plan (UOPP), and active employees in the City A Teachers Plan. An election will be conducted on Thursday, February 12, 2015.

If you wish to be a candidate, you can obtain a qualifying petition from the Retirement Office by:

Knox County Schools Certified Teachers (other than City A Teachers Plan participants) and employees in TCRS, as well as, Knox County Government Employees in TCRS are not eligible for this election.
